

Here are a few ways you can pray for our Youth Camp.

The Bible explains a few things about prayer that are absolutely crucial to cling to as you begin to pray for camp and to intercede on behalf of our students.

Nothing is too great for God.

*"Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh, is anything too hard for me?"
(Jeremiah 32:27)*

God always does what is good and right.

*"For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you."
(Psalm 86:5)*

God's wisdom is beyond our understanding.

*"Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!"
(Romans 11:33)*

We pray because God has invited us to call out to Him in prayer.

*"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!"
(Matthew 7:7-11)*



Pray for Camp as a whole. Pray that these spiritual goals would be accomplished at Camp:

Pray that God would save lost students who attend Camp.

*"For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."
(Luke 19:10)*

Pray that God would open blind eyes and turn sinners from the power of Satan to God, so that they might receive forgiveness and new life in Christ.

*"to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me."
(Acts 26:18)*

Pray that students would be convicted by the Holy Spirit over sin.

*"And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: concerning sin, because they do not believe in me;"
(John 16:8-9)*

Pray that the students' hearts would be open and receptive to God's Word leading to a life of fruitfulness.

*"As for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it. He indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty."
(Matthew 13:23)*

Pray that God would send out some of our students to labor in the harvest.

*"And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."
(Luke 10:2)*

Pray that as God's Word is preached at Camp that it would have its full effect in the lives of our students.

*"For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it."
(Isaiah 55:10-11)*

Pray for our Camp Speaker Joe Reid, that God would give him boldness and clarity in preaching the gospel.

*"praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel"
(Ephesians 6:18-19)*

Pray for our worship gatherings at camp, that God would bless them and that they would be to His praise.

*"Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name."
(Hebrews 13:15)*
